

LOOKING TO HIRE: SUMMER CAMP COOK

We are looking to hire a summer camp cook for a remote hunting camp in the Northwest Territories (Gana River Outfitters). We are located in the Beautiful Mackenzie Mountains (about 45 minute flight from Norman Wells, NWT). Gana River Outfitters is only accessible by plane, as a result, once you are at camp you will not see town until you are on your way back home! You need to be comfortable with living in a remote location for the duration of your stay. Basecamp is located by a lake and surrounded by mountains. For an avid nature enthusiast this would be a beautiful place to spend a summer!

Job Description: Basecamp Cook.

You will need to be confident in your cooking skills and willing to work as a team. Most meals are common everyday type meals (ex. Pancakes, bacon, & eggs. Soup, biscuits, veggie. Steak, potato, vegetable, salad.) You will have help in the kitchen. All cooks work together as a team. This job will require flexibility and initiative. Jobs may vary depending on what is needed each day. Some days are extremely busy, while others may not be. We prepare food for guests and employees. We may prepare a meal for 8 people or all the way up to 25 people (depending who is at basecamp).

General Responsibilities:

- Cooking all meals and managing food service (including clean up & dishes)
- Proper storage and handling of food
- Working with food items that are available and using up leftovers.
- Baking bread, cookies, etc.
- Bag lunches ... if required for day hunts.
- Keeping kitchen & dining room clean
- Able to manage time wisely.
- Willing to be flexible.
- Willing to accommodate late arrival of guests.
- Keeping basecamp clean (upkeep of outhouses, washhouse, cabins)
- Wash kitchen and wash house towels, washcloths, and guest bedding.
- Hanging up meat in cold room as it comes in and processing it (no experience required we can train the right individual). We clean and prepare the meat for meals, and to send home with the guests if they ask. We also make hamburger, sausages, and jerky with the meat.
- May need to transfer guests with a ranger to our air strip, and collect drinking water from our hydro system.
- Must be able to "think on your feet" and adapt to changing conditions.
- Willing to work long hours.
- Be willing to work in a remote environment, and share a cabin with 2-3 other employee's (Room and board is included).
- When there are no guests on site we may do small maintenance or cleaning projects (painting, cleaning bbq and stoves, etc)
- There will be opportunity to go hiking, canoeing, etc when times are not so busy.

Job begins: July 7th and ends around September 20th. If you are needing to leave end of August for school we can discuss it and make a plan that will work!
