To Whom It May Concern,

Our names are Greg Harris and Kyle Meeker, and we are co-Directing the Internship Program. We are excited that this program is entering its eighth year. The program is designed for Bible college students and recent grads. Through this program, emerging leaders grow and develop through practical ministry experience, and weekly teaching sessions. The program is 10 months long and starts in September. It is primarily designed to provide the opportunity for each intern to discern whether or not they are called to serve the local church in full-time vocational ministry. It's a place to put education into practice and a safe environment to grow through successes and failures. Over the course of the internship, there will be approximately 60 hours of theological teaching, and approximately 36 hours of other ministry related classes. Interns will visit a number of the ministries within our church to see how we strive to live out our Core Values. Interns will also visit a number of the ministries outside of Northview that we partner with to see how our church is engaged in ministry outside our own walls. It is a paid position (at this time, it's \$1200 per month), with the expectation of 40 hours worked per week. There are no costs associated with the program. All textbooks, teaching, office space, supplies, and other costs are covered (including a laptop, if the intern doesn't have one of their own).

Each intern works in one specific department of the church under the supervision of a pastor, who will mentor and lead him/her throughout the year. A majority of an intern's time is spent in one specific department. The rest of the time is primarily spent in the classes and visits mentioned above.

We value strong theological teaching alongside very practical ministry experience. Our desire is to help equip, empower, and encourage perseverance in Christian life and ministry.
